Delaying treatment for a cracked tooth, failing filling, or area of untreated decay can sometimes lead to more serious problems. Patients may notice sensitivity, discomfort while chewing, changes in appearance, or worsening damage over time. Restorative dentistry is intended to address those issues before they interfere more significantly with daily function.

Comfort and communication can also influence whether patients move forward with dental treatment.
